Course Summary

The VTCT hairdressing L2 diploma in Hairdressing is a substantial qualification for students seeking a career as a hairstylist. You will be expected to purchase a kit and source clients for assessment. Students will need to commit to two 3 hour twilight/evenings per week and be prepared to complete further independent study.

What You Will Learn

The course covers a broad range of hairdressing skills and knowledge. It is taught by highly qualified and enthusiastic staff in realistic working environments. Many aspects of hairdressing including cutting, colouring, blow-drying, setting and dressing hair.

- Client consultation for hair services
- Follow health and safety practice in the salon

Entry Requirements

Entry to this course requires requires 3 GCSEs at a minimum of a grade 4 or C including GCSE English and Maths or be working towards Level 2 Functional Skills in English and Maths. Experience of working in a hair salon is desirable.

You will be required to attend an interview in which you will be expected to complete a dexterity skills assessment and an individual interview.

Progression

Successful completion of this course offers progression to a Level 3 NVQ course, or employment.

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
