HIGHER LEVEL APPRENTICESHIPS



Are you currently employed and looking to progress to a senior level role within your organisation? Or perhaps you have set your sights on a different role within the company you work for but need to acquire the skills before you can move?

A Higher Level Apprenticeship combines onthe-job training with studying for a Level 4 or 5 qualification, nurturing your talent and enabling you to acquire additional skillsets that will make you an asset to the company you work for.

A Level 4 Apprenticeship is equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree, or a Higher National Certificate (HNC), whereas a Level 5 Apprenticeship is equivalent to a foundation degree, or a Higher National Diploma (HND).

Higher Level Apprenticeships are funded by the Government, depending on your age and your company's size.

If you're not an existing employee but would like to apply for a Higher Level Apprenticeship, you will need to apply for vacancies listed on our website. Entry requirements differ from employer to employer.

Most employers will require you to have a Level 3 qualification related to the apprenticeship you are applying for, as well as GCSEs in English and Maths.

You will spend the majority of your time on the job, completing additional training, and the rest of your time completing theory-based learning at the College through online learning, day or block release.



ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION



If you need a bridge between your current qualifications and a university level degree, our Access to HE courses provide exactly that.

There is no upper age limit to study an Access to HE course, as long as you have your GCSEs in Maths and English.

Choose the subject that is most relevant to your desired career pathway. In a year's time you will have earned a Level 3 qualification and be able to progress on to university level study.

Our Access courses are for students who are aged 19+ and are recognised by universities across the UK (if you are 18, you must turn 19 by September 1st of that year).

If you take out an Advance Learner Loan to fund your course tuition fee, and go on to complete an eligible Higher Education course, the load will be written off.

During your time as an Access student, you'll have the opportunity to participate in course-related field trips and attend lectures from professionals in your chosen career sector, providing you with the perfect foundation for further university-level studies.

With small class sizes, and all the individual support you need to get back into education, you'll build the skills, knowledge and confidence you need to succeed and reach your goal.



We will also introduce you to the UCAS system and provide tutorial sessions for university applications.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN



For Access to HE (Level 3) courses only.

The Advanced Learner Loan is a governmentfunded loan that is easy to apply for, doesn't take your household income into account, and doesn't involve a credit check.

To qualify for the Advanced Learner Loan you must be:

- Studying at an approved college or training provider. Bradford College is an approved centre
- 19 years of age or older on the first day of your course
- Studying a full- or part-time Further
 Education qualification at Level 3 or above
- A UK resident or a UK national, or have 'settled status' (this means there are no restrictions on how long you can stay)
- A resident in the UK for three years or more

You will need to pay your loan back when:

- You have finished your course
- You earn more than £25,000

Student Finance England will 'write off' any outstanding Advanced Learner Loan balances you owe for an Access to HE course once you complete a higher education course. This means you do not have to repay it.

APPLICANTS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS



UCAS is removing the application fee for students in receipt of free school meals to make higher education more accessible for young people in financial hardship. For those applying for 2025 entry and beyond, teachers and advisers will verify eligible students through the adviser portal, and these students will not be required to pay the fee on completion of their UCAS application.

DISABLED STUDENTS' ALLOWANCE



You may claim Disabled Students' Allowance (DSA) in addition to your student finance loans and grants to cover any extra study-related costs you incur due to an impairment, mental health condition, or learning difficulty. It's neither a benefit nor a loan, so it doesn't need repaying.

The amount you receive depends on your individual needs, not on your income. The DSA is available to both full-time and part-time students studying on a Higher Education course.
