It's a fundamental skill in the construction industry, which is a major part of the UK economy. As a bricklayer, you'll play a vital role in this important work, especially in the house-building sector. The government has set ambitious targets to build many more homes in the coming years, which means there's a growing demand for skilled bricklayers. #### **COURSE DURATION**

24 months + EPA (End Point Assessment).

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

You can join with a minimum of GCSE grade 3 in Maths and English (or equivalent). If you are over 19 when starting the apprenticeship and do not have GCSEs in Maths and English, you are not required to complete Functional Skills unless the company you work for requests it. However, you still have the option to complete them if desired.

#### **COURSE DELIVERY METHOD**

This apprenticeship combines practical work placements with classroom-based learning. Apprentices will gain hands-on experience in the workplace, supported by regular assessments, and spend one day a month at the College for theoretical and classroom-based learning.

#### **FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES**

Once you complete the apprenticeship, you'll be eligible to get a Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) card at the right level. You'll also be fully qualified to City & Guilds standards, opening up more job opportunities in the construction industry.
